- The Murdoch Psychology Clinic provides a low fee service to people in the community, delivered by our postgraduate clinical psychology trainees. Treatment is based on leading edge research on clinical problems with high quality, intensive supervision of the trainees from experienced clinical psychologist staff in the School of Psychology.
- Help is offered for a range of problems, including:
 - Problems experienced by children, adolescents and families
 - Headache and pain management
 - Anxiety, depression and stress-related problems
 - Bereavement and grief issues
 - Relationship problems
- There is no limit on the number of sessions per client, and wait times will be as short as possible from beginning of April when the Clinic re-opens.
- Consultation is also available with some Clinical staff at professional rates.

Generally Monday to Friday
9.00am-5.00pm. Late afternoon appointments can be negotiated

Fee

Usually \$20 per session; \$10 if on benefits. Under some conditions the fee can be waived
